Responsibilities

- Knowledge of who is in the building at all times (includes program residents and guests)
- Oversee the safety of people throughout the night (making inside and outside hourly rounds)
- Supervise the activity of the overnight guest population through morning routines
- Communicate pertinent shelter information and emergency interaction to succeeding shifts
- Answer all phone calls until morning shift arrives
- Informally counsel both resident and guests in coordination with Program Director/Counselors, as time allows
- Evangelize as God directs
- Coordinate early morning resident chore assignments and work duties
- Directly report to and communicate with Program Director
- Perform any duties/tasks the Program Director or President requests.
- Commit to working Thanksgiving Day (Great Thanksgiving Banquet) and the Back-to-School Rally (2nd Saturday in Aug.).
